


TECHNICAL DIRECTOR JOB POSTING

You'll steward and maintain our technical systems, develop and equip a dynamic volunteer team, and ensure seamless internal and external facility use. WHERE ARE WE?

Lakeview Church is located in the south east area of Saskatoon. A growing, friendly city of 270,000 people, Saskatoon has the amenities and action of a large city, with the relaxed vibes of small city hospitality.

It's a progressive city that stays in touch with its roots; surprisingly diverse yet incredibly inclusive, with a bright future that springs from a fascinating past.

A 20 minute drive can take you from one end of town to the other where you can discover world class restaurants, an amazing arts and music scene, and endless outdoor activities along the South Saskatchewan River. Saskatoon enjoys one of the lowest costs of living among major cities in Canada and offers a range of neighbourhoods to call home.

WHO ARE WE?

Lakeview Church has been active in Saskatoon for over 100 years. We are part of the Free Methodist Church in Canada, a worldwide movement with historical ties to the abolishment of slavery, early advocation of women's rights, child labour reform, and the establishment of hospitals and schools.

Our church community is wonderfully diverse and passionate. We have people of all ages and stages from a variety of cultural backgrounds. Our average attendance at our worship services is 500 people.

Our staff team is dynamic and loves to laugh together. We have 8 staff positions on our Pastoral team, 9 staff positions on our Operations team, and 8 Daycare staff positions.

Sunday worship services and Home Church are the central expression of church life at Lakeview. We value gathering as a collective community, and cultivating deep relationships.

Our Auditorium features seating for 700 with high quality audio production equipment. In addition to hosting our worship services, our Auditorium has served as a venue for local productions like Joy of Vox, along with major concert productions like Rend Collective. Our facility also features a variety of multi-purpose spaces that host a variety of ministries and community events.

POSITION PROFILE – TECHNICAL DIRECTOR

Position Overview

The Technical Director will provide expert oversight and direction to sound, lighting, videography, and other production related aspect of Lakeview Church; working closely and in conjunction with the Worship Pastor to help execute and advise on creative vision and direction for the church, maintain our technical assets, develop and equip skilled volunteers, and coordinating with Director of Operations to manage facility usage.

Reports To: Worship Arts Pastor

Position Terms: Full-time, permanent position. Salary to be negotiated.

Expected Hours of Work: 40–45 hours / week.

Minimum Education and Job Related Experience:

Education - High school diploma.

Experience – 1-3 years experience managing production in comparable environments

Preferred Education and Job Related Experience:

Education – Certificate or diploma in a related post-secondary technical/production program Experience – Management of Sound and/or Lighting in a large church (500+ people)



CORE RESPONSIBILITIES

Implementing Creative Vision- 20%

- Oversee technical logistics to implement the creative vision for services.
- Develop systems and processes to sustain the creative vision.
- Collaborate on auditorium stage design with Worship Arts Pastor.
- Oversee media asset creation to support worship services and ministry activities.

Managing Technical Assets - 25%

- Oversee audio, lighting, graphic design, photography, and videography for all church functions.
- Develop and implement maintenance and repair schedules for all technical equipment.
- Stay current with emerging technologies and best practices; lead implementation of improvements that enhance technical operations.
- Develop and manage a long-term strategy to anticipate and meet the church's evolving technical and equipment needs.
- Maintain and develop relationships with vendors and service providers.

Develop and Manage Technical Teams - 25%

- Recruit, develop, and equip volunteer teams and high-capacity leaders.
- Provide direction, training, and support for volunteers.
- Empower, coach, and delegate to increase volunteer capacity.
- Collaborate with technical contractors to build strong working relationships and a shared knowledge base.
- Supervise staff, volunteers, and contractors for audio, lighting, graphic design, photography, and videography.
- Train volunteers and staff in the use of physical and digital tools. (e.g. Proclaim, ProPresenter, Dante, Onyx, Adobe Suite, Canva, DaVici Resolve, Atem, etc.)

Resource Internal Ministries & External Client Events - 20%

- Ensure technical resources are in place for internal ministries and external client events.
- Build and maintain a network of tech contractors with a range of expertise to meet the needs
 of external events.
- Collaborate with the Director of Operations to assess client needs, allocate resources, and ensure successful event execution.

Major Events - 10%

- Collaborate in the planning and execution of major church events and facility rentals.
- Coordinate production elements that enhance the vision and intent of large-scale events.

Decision Making and Problem Solving

Taking action in solving problems while exhibiting judgement and a realistic understanding of the situation.

Developing People

Reviewing and analyzing others' strengths and weaknesses, to distinguish their talents and development needs, and enhancing them appropriately.

Working cooperatively with other individuals and making valued contributions to the outputs of others and the team.
