Position Terms: Full-time, permanent position. Wage will be based on ECE qualifications.

Expected Hours of Work: 35-40 hours / week.

Minimum Education and Job Related Experience:

- High School Diploma
- Experience working with kids
- Possession of or willingness to obtain CPR and First Aid
- Criminal Record Check, including a vulnerable sector check
- Meet or exceed the qualifications of Early Childhood Education Level 1



CORE RESPONSIBILITIES

Curriculum Planning and Implementation

- Design and implement age-appropriate learning experiences and lesson plans that align
- with developmental milestones.
- Select and provide a wide variety of materials that support and promote the physical,
- cognitive, emotional and social development of children.
- Implement inclusive practices and programming.

Child Interaction and Development

- Establish a safe, nurturing, and inclusive environment that supports children's learning and well-being.
- Observe children for signs of potential learning or behavioural problems and adjust the learning approaches accordingly.
- Ensure physical and psychological safety of children, oversee hygiene practices of dressing and toileting, and teach children about healthy habits of proper eating and safety precautions.

Classroom Management and Safety

- Ensure a safe and healthy learning environment.
- Supervise children during all activities, including indoor and outdoor play.
- Maintain a positive and respectful classroom environment.
- Implement and practice emergency procedures.

Communication and Collaboration

- Communicate effectively with parents and guardians about their children's progress and
- development.
- Collaborate with other professionals, such as early intervention specialists or therapists.
- Participate in staff meetings and professional development opportunities.

Facilitation and Engagement

Creating engaging and stimulating learning environments that foster curiosity and exploration. Facilitation learning through play, activities, and hands-on experiences.

Classroom Management

Creating a positive and supportive classroom environment where children feel safe and secure. Managing behaviours, addressing conflicts, and ensuring a smooth flow of activities.

Flexibility and Adaptability

Being able to adapt to unpredictable and changing circumstances and individual needs.

Leadership

Influencing actions and opinions of others in a desired direction; exhibiting judgement in leading others to worthwhile objectives.

Planning and Organizing

Determining goals and priorities and to assess the actions, time and resources needed to achieve those goals.

Collaboration

Working cooperatively with other individuals and making valued contributions to the outputs of others and the team.

Verbal Expression

Communicating in a clear language and adjusting one's use of language to the audience's level.

Creativity

Coming up with original ideas and solutions, to adopt points of view outside the usual parameters.

Conflict Management

Handling conflicting interests diplomatically and working towards effective resolution.
