Our church community is wonderfully diverse and passionate. We have people of all ages and stages from a variety of cultural backgrounds. Our average attendance at our worship services is 500 people.

Our staff team is dynamic and loves to laugh together. We have 7 staff positions on our Pastoral team, and 9 staff positions on our Operations team.

Sunday worship services and Home Church are the central expression of church life at Lakeview. We value gathering as a collective community and cultivating deep relationships.

Each week we average over 100 children in Lakeview Kids, divided into dedicated spaces for Infants, Toddlers, Pre-School, Kindergarten-Grade 3, and Grades 4/5. We have an incredible team of 130+ volunteers serving Kids in a variety of ways.

Position Terms: Part-time, permanent position. Salary to be negotiated.

Expected Hours of Work: 25 hours / week.

Minimum Education and Job Related Experience:

- High School Diploma.
- Experience leading a kids ministry, developing leaders and providing pastoral care.

Preferred Education and Job Related Experience:

- Bible College degree or Bachelors of Education.
- Multiple years working full-time in kids ministry.

CORE RESPONSIBILITIES

Elementary Program Planning – 40%

- Develop creative, age appropriate program plans that promote spiritual, social, and emotional development.
- Prepare curriculum materials and delivery strategy.
- Schedule volunteers.
- Communicate program and curriculum logistics to volunteers.
- Prepare program space and materials.
- Collaborate with Daycare staff to maintain classrooms and equipment.

Elementary Program Facilitation – 30%

- Point leadership for Sunday programs.
- Oversight of volunteer teams.
- Encourage volunteers to engage with children relationally.
- Nurture relationships among children.
- Ensure age appropriate learning environments.
- Ensure all programming is in compliance with Plan to Protect.
- Support Family Formation Pastor with major events.

Elementary Leader Development – 30%

- Recruit, train, and supervise volunteers.
- Invest relationally in the lives of volunteers.
- Provide pastoral care and support to volunteers.

REQUIRED BEHAVIOURS & SKILLS

Leadership

Influencing actions and opinions of others in a desired direction; exhibiting judgement in leading others to worthwhile objectives.

Planning and Organizing

Determining goals and priorities and to assess the actions, time and resources needed to achieve those goals.

Collaboration

Working cooperatively with other individuals and making valued contributions to the outputs of others and the team.

Developing People

Reviewing and analyzing others' strengths and weaknesses, to distinguish their talents and development needs, and enhancing them appropriately.

Delegating

Assigning responsibilities and authority to the right people, taking their interests, ambitions, development and competency into account. Following up on delegated tasks.

Innovative Power

Directing one's energy toward initiating new strategies, programs, and initiatives.

Creativity

Coming up with original ideas and solutions, to adopt points of view outside the usual parameters.

Comfortable in people's company, meeting people easily, mingling freely.

Verbal Expression

Communicating in a clear language and adjusting one's use of language to the audience's level.

Conflict Management

Handling conflicting interests diplomatically and working towards effective resolution.
